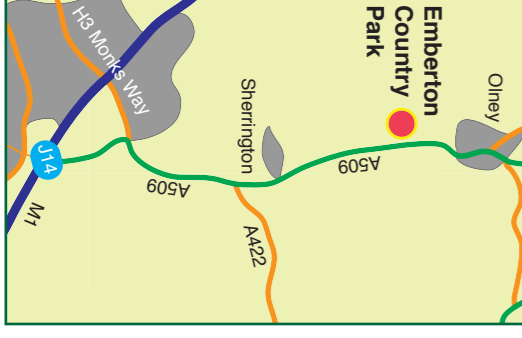
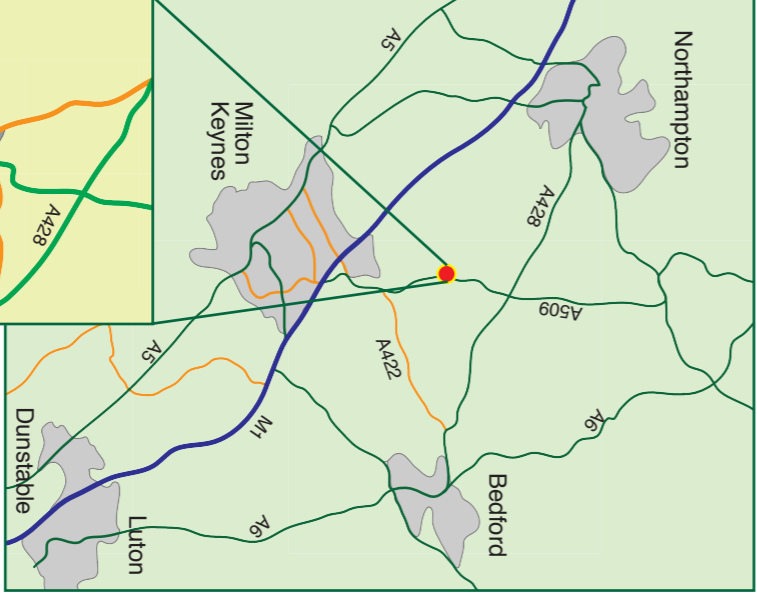

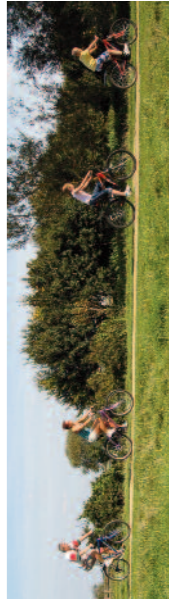
Welcome to your Emberton Country Park guide

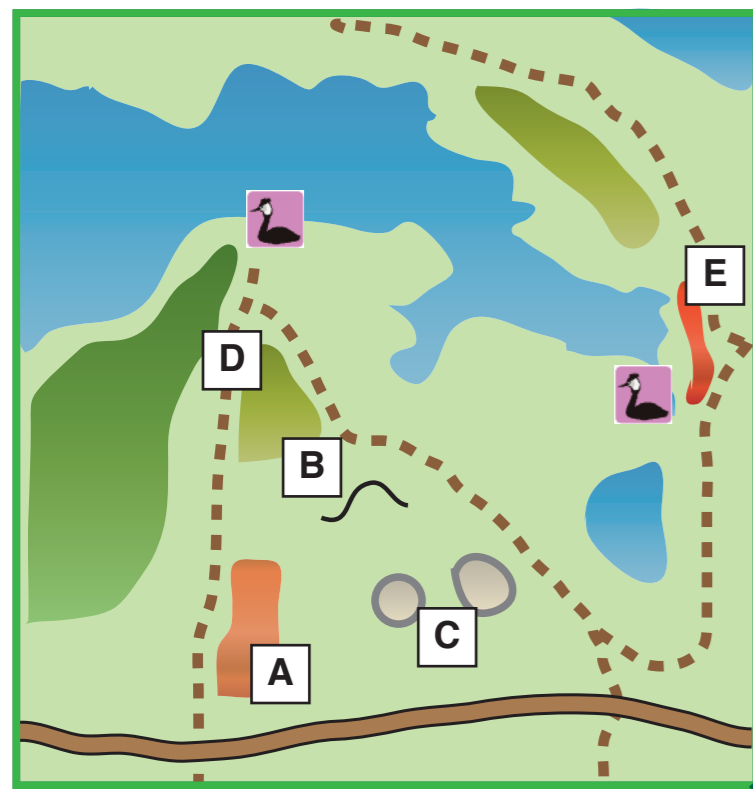
Picnics and BBQ's
